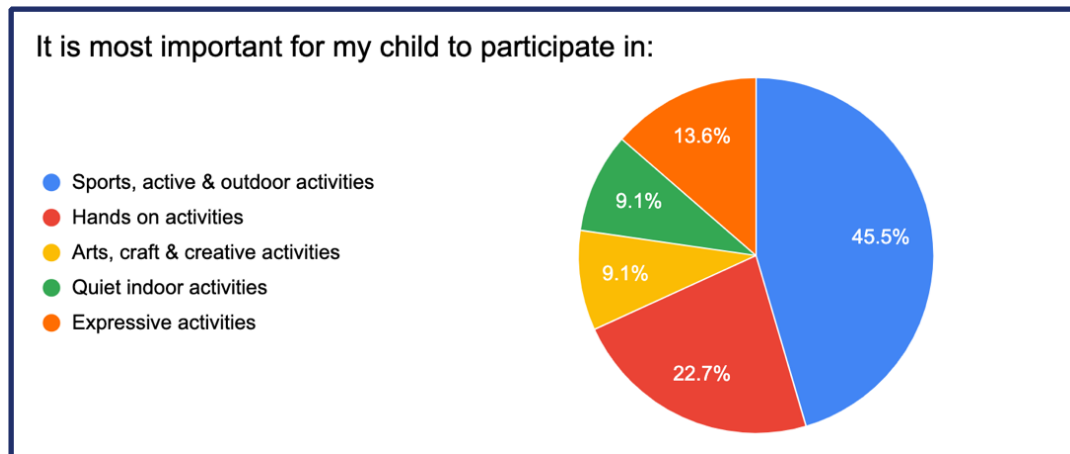


## Term 1 2021 NTOOSHC Parents Survey Responses for their Child/rens Interests
